The method here set forth has been thoroughly tried and has proved to be unusually successful. Its fundamental idea is to group together those verb forms in which the stem is common, disregarding for this purpose the order of persons and tenses, as they appear in the usual conjugations. In applying the method, therefore, the pupil should not be asked to conjugate a verb, viz.: je lis, tu lis, il lit, etc.; but having been given the stem and taught the endings, he should be asked to translate a variety of English verb forms into French; care being taken in each question to change verb, person and tense. Questioning in this way keeps the pupils alert and easily holds their attention. It is also well to have pupils write the answers, to familiarize them with the appearance of the forms as well as with their pronunciation. In...
