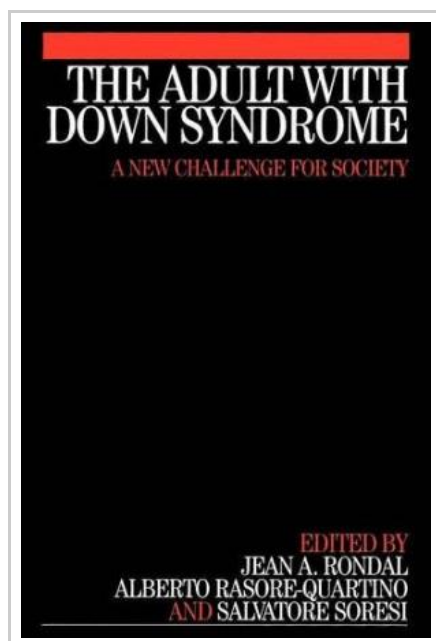




The Adult with Down Syndrome: A New Challenge for Society (Paperback)
