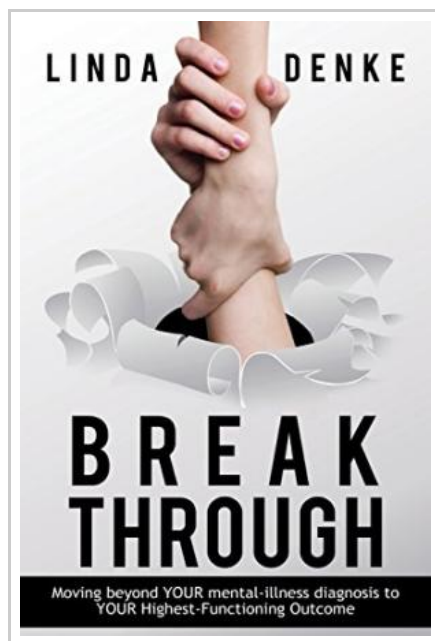




Breakthrough - Moving Beyond Your Mental-Illness Diagnosis to Your Highest-Functioning Outcome (Paperback)
